TEGA CAY, S.C.,– (Aug 2, 2019) The City of Tega Cay is updating its Comprehensive Plan and as a part of community outreach, electronic surveys are available for residents to complete. These short surveys give participants an opportunity to share their ideas on Tega Cay’s challenges and its possibilities. One survey includes questions on community characteristics and values while the other survey is an interactive mapping tool allowing resident feedback on walking and biking opportunities throughout the City.

“The Comprehensive Plan influences how our community develops and reflects our community values. The surveys are opportunities for residents to give feedback for the update to the Comprehensive Plan,” stated David O’Neal, Tega Cay Mayor. “The Comprehensive Plan Update will be adopted later in 2019 and will be based on a shared vision for the future of our City.”

People interested in sharing ideas for the future of Tega Cay have options to complete one or both surveys by August 31st, 2019. The Comprehensive Plan is mandated in the South Carolina Planning Act and includes elements on population, land use, priority investment, housing, transportation, economic development, community facilities, cultural resources and natural resources. The City is adding an element to the plan with this update: Health and Active Living.

Residents will have other means to actively participate in developing the Comprehensive Plan through community meetings and public hearings that will occur through the end of December 2019.
