City of York Seeks Community Input

York, SC. The City of York is embarking on a strategic planning project to identify community goals and objectives for the next three to five years. The City, with assistance from the Catawba Regional Council of Governments, seeks community input to assess the current state of services and vision for the future. Residents, businesses and those interested in the future of the White Rose City are encouraged to complete a community survey.

“We hope everyone will take a few minutes to complete the survey and provide their input and ideas on the direction of our community,” said Mayor Mike Fuesser. “This is an opportunity for everyone to get involved and help build a better tomorrow.”

The short survey gives participants an opportunity to share their ideas on York’s facilities, programs and vision for the future. This is the City’s first strategic planning project and will help shape future decisions of Council and staff.

“The responses provided by our community will help give Council and staff direction and focus in the years ahead,” said Mayor Mike Fuesser.
