They Agency provide transportation service to Individuals with intellectual disabilities residing in York County and are clients of the York County Board of Disabilities and Special Needs Board. The Agency serves over 1,150 families located in the Catawba area of South Carolina. They service areas such as Fort Mill, York, Clover, Lake Wylie, Tega Cay, McConnells, Hickory Grove, Sharon. The Agency hours of operation are Monday - Friday, 8:30 am - 5 pm. ADA vehicle is needed to safety transport persons with physical disabilities requiring wheelchair transportation options. Currently, York County DSNB do not have adequate ADA vehicles in their facilities. While they are meeting the current needs of the persons served, several of the vehicles require visits to the shop for repairs or wheelchair lift repairs. Spare vehicles are needed which can be achieved with the funding of this additional ADA vehicle. They Agency assist their clients with transportation to and from work, home, medical appointments, and day-to-day errands such as shopping for groceries and going home to visit family. They seek to provide a reliable and safer transportation options of the people they serve. Existing vehicles can be used as spares to backup this newer vehicle awarded with this grant request.
	Union	Union County DSNB	STIP Category: Capitol Project Type: Cutaway Vehicle Type : Replacement			125								125		Union County Disabilities and Special Needs Board (UCDSNB) will use funds to purchase two replacement cutaways, a 2016 Ford E350 Cutaway, VIN #1FDEE3FLOGDC23468 with 118,165 and a 2018 Dodge Grand Caravan, VIN #2C4RDGBG1JR180529 with 90,848 miles that have met the useful life. Union County DSNBCDSNB provides early intervention, family training services, residential supports, and day habilitation supports to approximately 95 consumers in Union County. The residential supports are provided across 9 group homes/independent apartments and transportation is available by family style minivans at each location. Union County is a very rural community and UCDSNB supports the communities of Union, Santuc, Carlisle, Jonesville, Lockhart, and Buffalo. These two vehicles will be used to transport consumers with intellectual and related disabilities to the Adult Day Activity Center Monday through Friday from 7am until 4pm. The Adult Day Activity Center provides prevocational training opportunities and career preparation services to adults with lifelong disabling conditions that allow them to grow in knowledge and skill in preparation for transition to meaningful employment in their community. Besides the training and support, consumers earn money for the work they do.
